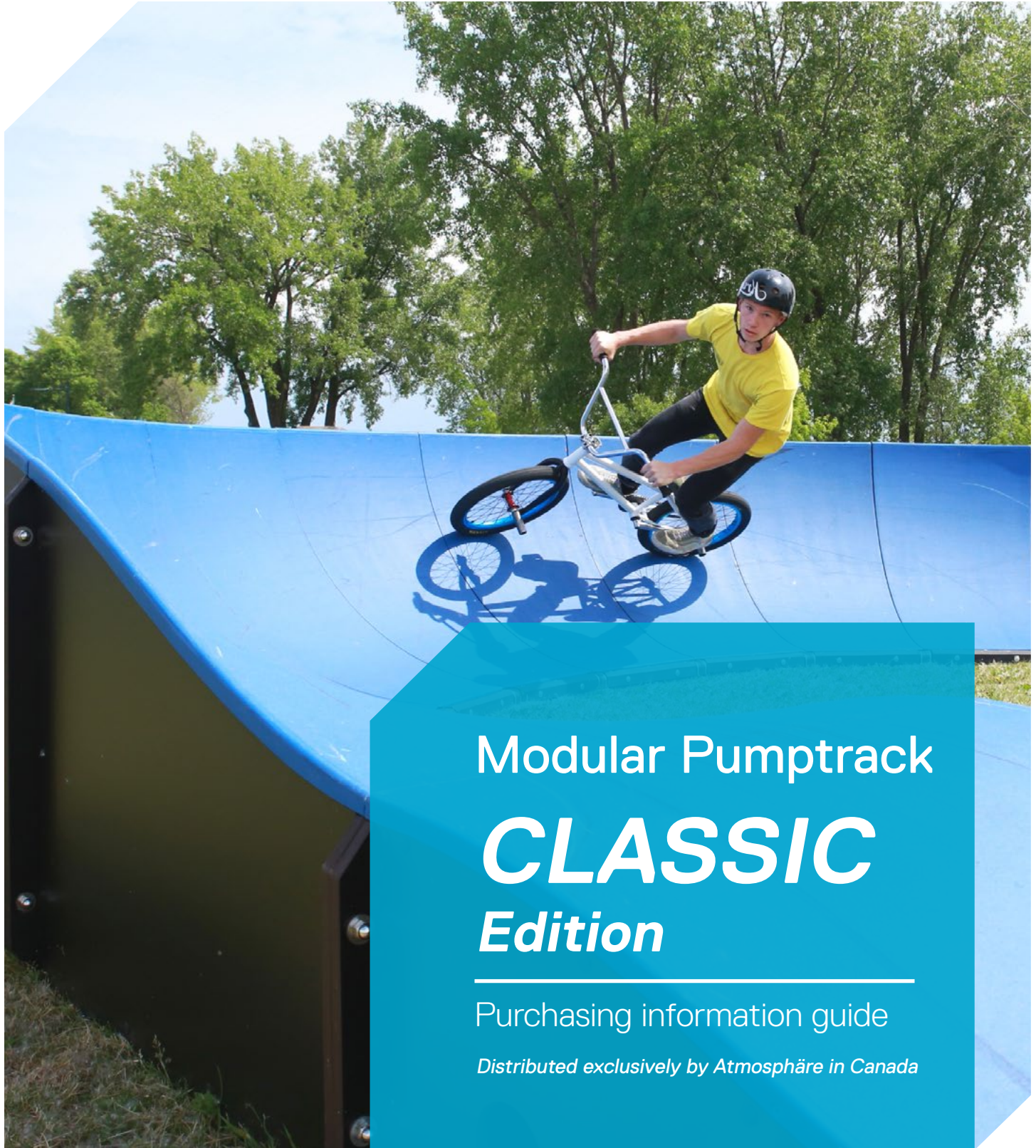

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What is a «Pumptrack»?

A Pumptrack is a closed bike circuit with a succession of bumps and banked turns.

The basic idea is that you never pedal in a Pumptrack, and that's without putting aside the cardio aspect and the benefits of physical activity.

We use the movements of the ground to pump, thanks to the action of the arms and legs, flexion/extension, but also the displacement of the center of gravity linked to anterior-posterior balance. The only forces acting on the user are those he or she is able to generate himself or herself. As a result, requirements increase with the degree of know-how and evolve over time.

Recommendations on user capabilities

New Pumptrack users are advised to start with sports equipment with which they are familiar. The following is a guideline only. Users are welcome to use any equipment at their discretion, provided they comply with the safety rules.

- Beginner** - first use of Pumptrack equipment
- Elementary** - basic balancing and handling skills before using the Pumptrack
- Intermediate** - comfortable skill level before using the Pumptrack
- Advanced** - sufficient level of skill before using the Pumptrack

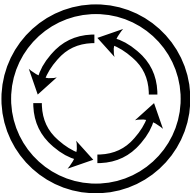


Safety rules

- Roller sports are inherently risky. Rolling on a Pumptrack presents a risk of injury and is solely at the user's own risk.
- All Pumptrack users are obliged to familiarize themselves with the rules before venturing out.
- Protective helmets are mandatory for users in all circumstances. All other protective equipment is recommended.
- Users must only drive within the limits of their ability.
- Users must always remain in control and be able to stop at any time.
- Motorized vehicles are not allowed.
- The Pumptrack is not designed for wheeled equipment with 3 or more wheels, such as go-karts, wagons, tricycles, bicycles with training wheels, baby carriages, etc.
- When the Pumptrack is used by several users at the same time, it is at their own risk. All users must ride in the same direction and maintain a safe distance from each other to avoid collisions.
- The Pumptrack must not be used;
 - in adverse weather conditions, such as thunderstorms,
 - in poor lighting conditions,
 - if the running surface is damaged,
 - if incomplete,
 - if closed.
- If any danger or damage is detected on or around the Pumptrack, the user is obliged to cease use immediately and report it immediately to the owner or operator. The Pumptrack must not be used until the hazard or damage has been rectified.
- The owner or operator of the Pumptrack is responsible for the visible display of operating rules and safety instructions in the area surrounding the Pumptrack.
- Entrance, exit and escape routes to the Pumptrack area must be accessible at all times and unobstructed.
- Safety rules are located on the perimeter of the equipment.



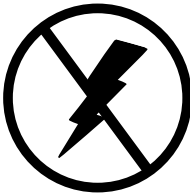

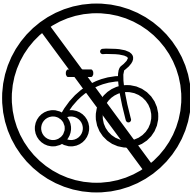
